

## **CALL FOR PAPERS**2022 Annual Meeting

You are encouraged to submit a research paper or a proposal to present research findings at the 2022 meeting of the Western Risk & Insurance Association (WRIA) in beautiful Waikiki, Hawaii. Papers on any risk management or insurance related topic are welcome. WRIA meetings are known for their relaxed, friendly, and collegial atmosphere. This meeting should prove to be another enjoyable and educational event, and we hope to see you there!

Please submit a research paper or a proposal (3-5 pages) that describes your intended presentation at the meeting. Your submission must include three keywords, the names and affiliations of all co-authors, with all phone, fax and e-mail addresses with designated contact, on the cover page. Any/all topics related to risk management, insurance, employee benefits, financial planning, estate planning, and other insurance-related topics will be considered. Pedagogical proposals (classroom, program, industry connections) are also welcome.

Submissions from doctoral students are encouraged, and if indicated, will be considered for the Dorfman Award. For consideration for the Dorfman Award, the following items must be submitted by the conference submission deadline: a completed research paper as the paper submission, a statement of interest indicating a desire to be considered for the Dorfman Award, and a letter signed by an advisor confirming doctoral student status and your involvement in the paper. Attendance and presentation of the paper at the annual meeting is also necessary for consideration of the award. If any of the above items are missing or incomplete, the submission will not be considered for the Dorfman Award. Please see the WRIA homepage for further details.

The deadline for all submissions is extended to October 31, 2021, due to uncertainty surrounding potential pandemic restrictions. This deadline will not be further extended.

Decisions regarding presentation acceptance will be announced by mid-November.

The Dorfman Award winner will be announced at the meeting.
